## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The Piedmont Triad Airport Authority will receive Bids for the Northwest Development, Phase 1 – Clearing, Grubbing and E&S Controls Project, in the Stanley Frank Board Room at the Piedmont Triad International Airport, until 2:00 pm on **Thursday, November 30, 2017**, at which time and place all Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after 2:00 pm on **Thursday, November 30, 2017** will not be accepted.

This project consists of clearing and grubbing, earthwork, erosion control items, seeding, mulching, and other incidental items necessary to complete the project.

Bid Security equal to 5% of the total Bid is required in the form of a cash deposit or a Bid Bond. Contract Security in the form of 100% Performance and Payment Bonds will be required. No Bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of Bids for a period of ninety (90) consecutive calendar days.

A Pre-Bid Conference Meeting was held at the Stanley Frank Board Room at the Piedmont Triad International Airport on Wednesday, November 1, 2017 at 2:00 pm. The purpose of this meeting was to familiarize the prospective bidders with the proposed project. The meeting covered contract scope, security badging requirements bid items, schedule requirements, and any questions from those in attendance.
