Dear Neighbor,

As you are probably aware, air traffic at the Piedmont Triad International Airport has been operating below its normal levels over the past several months because of the COVID-19 virus' impact on passenger airline and air cargo traffic.

As of April, the FedEx Mid-Atlantic Hub, located at the Airport, suspended its nighttime hub operations, which means ten aircraft that had been flying to and from the Airport in the late evening and early morning have not been operating.


FedEx has informed the Airport Authority that it plans to resume nighttime hub operations with eight aircraft beginning on September 28, 2020.

As in the past, the flights will arrive Monday through Thursday nights between 10:30pm to 1:00am and depart around 3:00am to 4:00am. FedEx runway use during this nighttime hub operation should be approximately the same as before with most, but not all, arrivals from the southwest and departures to the southwest, using the Airport's primary runway. This operational pattern minimizes noise for neighbors nearest the Airport. Runway use is ultimately determined by FAA Air Traffic Control and is subject to wind, weather, traffic, and the requirements of airspace safety and efficiency.

The Airport Authority will keep you informed regarding any future changes in air traffic that we believe will be of interest to our neighbors.
